

Welfare innovations at the local level in favour of cohesion

MISSING DATA REPORT

This report is part of Work Package 3 of the research project entitled "Welfare innovations at the local level in favour of cohesion" (WILCO). WILCO aims to examine, through cross-national comparative research, how local welfare systems affect social inequalities and how they favour social cohesion, with a special focus on the missing link between innovations at the local level and their successful transfer to and implementation in other settings. The WILCO consortium covers ten European countries and is funded by the European Commission (FP7, Socio-economic Sciences & Humanities).



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1. BIRMINGHAM, UK

What have been the main problems you had in collecting data to answer to the WP3 City Report Template?

- Data available on a "national" level varies: England, England & Wales (E&W), Great Britain (GB) which only includes England, Scotland and Wales, and the United Kingdom which also includes Northern Ireland.
- Some data are only available from the 2001 national census so not very currentthe census takes place every ten years, data from 2011 are not in the public domain.
- Public expenditure information on welfare and other services is not publicly available at a national or a local level.
- Some data were only available as a "snapshot" from research or commissioned reports so trends could not be established.

2. MEDWAY, UK

What have been the main problems you had in collecting data to answer to the WP3 City Report Template?

- Some data are only available from the 2001 national census so not very recent. The census only takes place every ten years and the data from 2011 are still awaited.
- Public expenditure information on services is not publicly available at a national or a local level.
- There isn't data on take up rates of benefits or services at a local level.
- Some data were only available at one point in time from research or commissioned reports or by contacting Medway Council directly, so trends could not be established.
- A lot of labour market data is publicly available on the Office for National Statistics "NOMIS" website, but this only goes back to 2004.
- Although there is quite a lot of data on ethnic minorities, data on migrants isn't routinely collected.

3. STOCKHOLM, SE

What have been the main problems you had in collecting data to answer to the WP3 City Report Template?

Stockholm has a statistical office with a fairly comprehensive amount of data with open access, which means that the city is rather well covered with statistics on various indicators which also is available. Some indicators have been changed between years, which cause some problems with showing trends. In the report data from this statistical office in Stockholm has been supplemented with regional/local data from Statistics Sweden, and other sources of information. But even though there are available data on different indicators for Stockholm it has not fully corresponded to the wanted indicators in WP3 and therefore there have been some problems with data collection.

Some examples on problems:

- Swedish labour market statistics is rather complicated to interpret. The statistics are presented by a number of different indicators, by the different reporting authorities. There are some doubts about the correspondence of the reported statistics in the city report in relation to the requested, and how this is comparable to other countries.
- In Stockholm the statistics in different areas cover different territorial and/or administrative delimitations e.g. City of Stockholm, Stockholm county, Stockholm metropolitan area.
- As also mentioned in the missing data report on Malmö, data on segregation is restricted by a sensitivity in Sweden towards this issue. Data on ethnicity is e.g. not available.
- Data in the housing field does not cover families/individuals with housing problems. These issues were at least partly covered by the former Population and Housing Censuses, but these surveys have not been completed since 1990. Surveys are made on homelessness, but these do not cover e.g. overcrowding, affordability, risk of eviction or subsidized rent.
- Social housing does not exist in Sweden.

4. MALMÖ, SE

What have been the main problems you had in collecting data to answer to the WP3 City Report Template?

Sweden in general and the city of Malmö in particular have a long tradition of collecting data on various indicators. As a result, compiling data for the purpose of the city reports has been a fairly straightforward task, despite a few problems. The two main problems were the following:

- The city of Malmö collects data on various indicators and provides summaries on for example its website. However, the underlying data is not made available to the public. It was therefore possible to include data that already was made available. In comparison, Statistics Sweden makes its data available and searchable by various factors such as age, gender, and so on. Most data in the city report of Malmö comes as a consequence from Statistics Sweden.
- Another problem has been related to differences among the participating countries in the WILCO-project. For example, segregation is a politically sensitive issue in Sweden, and collecting data on segregation is at times restricted by such sensitivity. Another example: social housing does not exist in Sweden. As a consequence, data on some of the required indicators does simply not exist.

5. CITY: AMSTERDAM, NL

What have been the main problems you had in collecting data to answer to the WP3 City Report Template?

As for the data concerning the socio-economic trends, one of the main problems was to establish the exact impact of certain socio-economic developments on the living conditions of our three target groups, as the link between these two is not always validated, especially when we are talking about the impact of more recent developments (such as the financial crisis). In addition, most statistical data distinguishes "allochthones" from "authochtones", which is different than distinguishing migrants from natives.

As for the data concerning public regulation, it was particularly difficult to establish the share of welfare that is carried out by public, private, or third sector actors, as often these three actors are involved in different aspects of one same welfare measure (financing, provision, supervision, etc.). It was also difficult to gather accurate figures on public expenditure, as welfare policies regarding unemployment, childcare and housing are often partially financed/subsidized by different layers of government as well as different actors.

6. NIJMEGEN, NL

What have been the main problems you had in collecting data to answer to the WP3 City Report Template?

For Nijmegen, there was no data available on temporary employment, which makes it difficult to assess trends in the share of precarious jobs among young unemployed. Also figures on housing problems were scarce or unreliable.

Other difficulties concerned more qualitative questions, such as "impact" of changes in societies were not easy to answer.

Furthermore, it was hard to say something about the exact "share" of public, private and third sector organizations in public services.

Additionally, public expenditure of local authorities were hard to assess, since expenditure is often shared by several actors over different stages or aspects of welfare measures.

More in general, in the Netherlands, many figures are available on "allochthones" but not specific for migrants. Also figures on asylum seekers are difficult to find.

7. MÜNSTER, DE

What have been the main problems you had in collecting data to answer to the WP3 City Report Template?

The territory of the City of Münster is identical with the NUTS3 region "DEA33 Münster, Kreisfreie Stadt". The majority of the requested basic indicators were available and comparable between Münster and Germany, with the exception of the indicators for the field of housing. For this field, there is almost no official data available.

Regarding labour market issues, detailed data on unemployment and on expenditures in labour market activities are not available for the local level. In the field of immigration, available data on certain issues refer to different groups ("immigrants", "foreigners", "population with migration background"). Comparability is not safeguarded. Also, data on the country of origin of immigrants is only partly available.

Detailed demographic data for specific indicators, especially data per nationality, educational status or age, is difficult to obtain since the data is generally not part of official reports focusing on the urban or local level.

With respect to the local level, there is by and large no data available on welfare expenditures or take up/coverage rates of welfare measures for specific target groups. This data is either not part of official reports or it is not systematically collected. Inquiries addressed at the respective local offices were not successful for several reasons, amongst those the amount of work involved for the offices and data protection.

The same holds true for data related to welfare and refugees.

Data on grey market economy is not available from official sources at all. Data from non-official sources are considered to be highly unreliable.

8. BERLIN / DISTRICT OF FRIEDRICHSHAIN-KREUZBERG, DE

What have been the main problems you had in collecting data to answer to the WP3 City Report Template?

In general, most of the requested basic indicators for Germany and Berlin were available and are comparable, except for the field of housing. For the specific district of Friedrichshain-Kreuzberg however, there is not much data available at all. The district Friedrichshain-Kreuzberg is not a NUTS region, while the city of Berlin is a NUTS2 region. With respect to Berlin, there are no subdivisions on the NUTS3 level.

There is a possibility to obtain data for the field of housing. However, this data is processed by private companies. It is not part of the official statistics and it is, furthermore, very expensive.

All in all, except the scarcity of official data for the sub-urban unit Friedrichshain-Kreuzberg, Berlin and Münster show many similarities with respect to data collections (see above report).

10. BERN, CH

What have been the main problems you had in collecting data to answer to the WP3 City Report Template?

The main problems encountered with respect to data about the city of Berne arose from a major recent change to the method used to collect official population and housing data. For the period 1850 to 2000, the available statistics on demographics, housing and the social field are based on a census of the whole population carried out every ten years. Since 2010, however, official statistics have been based on annual surveys of a representative sample of 5% of the population. This change has meant that finding data for the period since 2000 has been difficult. Statistics based on the data gathered in 2010 are only now becoming available. It has been necessary to combine data for different years and from different sources, the coverage of which is partial and which in some cases does not conform exactly to the official specification of indicators.

It proved to be impossible to find large scale data that would permit a direct comparison of the situation in 2000 and 2010.

Another problem arose with the comparison of the different NUTS levels, as the indicators used were not all based on the same definition.

Finally, most statistics no longer permit the disaggregation of data for the city of Berne itself, providing only aggregate data on the whole region of Bern-Mittelland.

Last available census data are 2001. Currently 2011 census data gathering is being completed, but data will only be available in a few months/years depending on data.

Since 2001, some data about socio-demographic trends and family structures are available, but sometimes these data are provisional, or estimated, or forecast, or based on experimental calculations.

Many official statistical data are only available at NUTS3 level, especially about labour market.

The National Statistics Institute data about Labour Force Survey are characterized by a caesura due to deep restructuring of the survey design in 2004, with some problems in time series.

Data about take-up rate and expenditures of local welfare programmes are complex to reconstruct, also because of many separated, often small programmes, based on different funds, with different eligibility criteria. Often available data are either too aggregated (e.g. budget of the whole respective Municipal sector) or too disaggregated (funds paid by the Municipality on a certain programme, per each NGO providing services, that may well vary year by year, and even disappear from one year to the other). Nevertheless, some data about number of beneficiaries of main municipal programs available.

What have been the main problems you had in collecting data to answer to the WP3 City Report Template?

The main problems in collecting data in Warsaw were related to the system of collecting the statistical data in Poland. For example, the detailed statistics on families and the structures of the households are gathered in National Censuses. The last one was carried out in year 2011 and the data are still processed, therefore we could use only the information based on the previous National Census, which took place in year 2002. Apart from National Censuses, there are statistical data on labour market and households in Poland in years 2000-2010, such as the results of the labour force survey and AZER, but they are based on the samples of the population of adult Poles and they are available only on the national and provincial level.

The other difficulties were related to the accessibility of specific statistical data, which are gathered and processed in particular entities within the Municipal Office in Warsaw. Due to the bureaucratic procedures and indifference of some officers, it usually takes up to few weeks to obtain the required data.

What have been the main problems you had in collecting data to answer to the WP3 City Report Template?

The main problems in collecting data in Płock were related to the population of immigrants. The data available on demand in the Municipal Office cover just the number of permanent residents being foreigners in years 2009 and 2010. Due to the relatively low inflow of immigrants in Poland, in comparison with the other EU countries, this group is not high on the local authorities' list of priorities, especially in medium-size provincial cities as Płock.

The other difficulties were linked to the system of collecting the statistical data in Poland. For example, the detailed statistics on families and the structures of the households are gathered in National Censuses. The last one was carried out in year 2011 and the data are still processed, therefore we could use only the information based on the previous National Census, which took place in year 2002. Apart from National Censuses, there are statistical data on labour market and households in Poland in years 2000-2010, such as the results of the labour force survey and AZER, but they are based on the samples of the population of adult Poles and they are available only on the national and provincial level.

On the local level, the problems with collecting data were also related to the structural reorganization of the public institutions in the studied period of time, as in case of the labour offices in Plock, which disrupts the cohesion of information. Similar difficulties were caused by the changes of the system of reporting data in these institutions.

THE WILCO PROJECT

Project's objective and mission:

WILCO aims to examine, through cross-national comparative research, how local welfare systems affect social inequalities and how they favour social cohesion, with a special focus on the missing link between innovations at the local level and their successful transfer to and implementation in other settings. The results will be directly connected to the needs of practitioners, through strong interaction with stakeholders and urban policy recommendations. In doing so, we will connect issues of immediate practical relevance with state-of-the-art academic research on how approaches and instruments in local welfare function in practice.

Brief description:

The effort to strengthen social cohesion and lower social inequalities is among Europe's main policy challenges. Local welfare systems are at the forefront of the struggle to address this challenge - and they are far from winning. While the statistics show some positive signs, the overall picture still shows sharp and sometimes rising inequalities, a loss of social cohesion and failing policies of integration.

But, contrary to what is sometimes thought, a lack of bottom-up innovation is not the issue in itself. European cities are teeming with new ideas, initiated by citizens, professionals and policymakers. The problem is, rather, that innovations taking place in the city are not effectively disseminated because they are not sufficiently understood. Many innovations are not picked up, because their relevance is not recognised; others fail after they have been reproduced elsewhere, because they were not suitable to the different conditions, in another city, in another country.

In the framework of WILCO, innovation in cities is explored, not as a disconnected phenomenon, but as an element in a tradition of welfare that is part of particular socio-economic models and the result of specific national and local cultures. Contextualising innovations in local welfare will allow a more effective understanding of how they could work in other cities, for the benefit of other citizens.
