Practicalities

Getting to Nijmegen

From Schiphol Airport, there is a direct connection at :29 and :59 past the hour. The journey takes 1,5 hours. Train timetables can be found at www.ns.nl. Do not buy a return ticket, as these are only valid on the same day.

From Brussels, change at Roosendaal to get a direct train to Nijmegen.

From Frankfurt, change at Arnhem.

Getting to the hotel

Participants will be staying at the hotel Mercure, which is next to the railway station, on the right as you exit. Your room has been pre-booked, but all participants must settle the bill themselves.

Getting to the meeting

The university can be reached by bus 10 (Heyendaal Shuttle), bus 3 (direction Wijchen), bus 4 (direction Wijchen), bus 6 (direction Brabantse Poort). Please get out at the stop 'UMC Sint Radboud' (not the university stops). Tickets can be bought on the bus.

Alternatively, take a taxi. If they do not know the address (Geert Groteplein-Noord 9), tell them it's close to the main entrance of the Radboud Hospital ("*Hoofdingang Radboud Ziekenhuis*") and show the picture on the next page.

Location of the meeting

The meeting will be held at Huize Heyendaal on the university campus (Geert Groteplein-Noord 9). This is the mansion (picture below) close to the main entrance of Radboud University Hospital. This is not within walking distance of the hotel.
